
World Pangolian Day

- In Quiz, there were two rounds, in first round the questions were distributed to the participants to answer and the second round was a buzzer round.

Pravah 24

Pravah is an intercollegiate science festival incepted in 2013 as one of the activities under the DBT-sponsored Star College Scheme.

The main objective of this activity is to dissolve the boundaries between the various streams of science and make it interdisciplinary.

Considering NEP 2020, Pravah is organized to make learning more experiential and pleasurable.

Every year the festival is organized with a new theme keeping up with the recent developments in science across the globe and the current needs of our nation.

For the academic year 2023-24, the theme of Pravah was 'Entrepreneurship in science'. The aim behind the theme was to make the students aware of the entrepreneurial opportunities available to them in the field of science which can probably make them job givers rather than job seekers.

The event was organized on Saturday, the 17th of February 2024. and BKBPS graced the occasion as chief guest and guest of honour respectively. Dr. Suhas Pedhnekar, Former Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai, and Mr. Subodh ji Dave, Vice President, BKBCK

Dr. Reena Pandit, Vice President (Biotechnology), Blue Ashva Innolabs Pvt. Ltd, Navi Mumbai, Dr. Rajendra Patil, Principal, Anna Leela College, Kurla, Mumbai, Mr. Anil Menon, Director, Uma Shetty College of Management and Research were the other dignitaries present for the event.

A panel of well-qualified judges was invited to the festival. Dr. Siddhivinayak Barve, Director, Scientific Research Centre, Kelkar Education Trust, Mulund, Mumbai, Dr. Aruna Rai, Former Head, Department of Botany, CHM College, Ulhas Nagar were among them.

This year the exhibits and displays were invited under 13 different subthemes for intercollegiate science exhibition while school children were motivated to display their projects in open theme under a **single activity of science exhibition**.

The public relations (PR) team comprising 40 student volunteers contacted 30 schools from Thane District and 40 colleges from Thane and Mumbai districts under the leadership of Student Coordinator Mr. Jiten Mahajan a student of M. Sc. Part -II (Chemistry). Besides this, the faculty members of the Science departments contacted the faculties of different colleges in their contact and promoted the activity.

We received 32 working models from schools and 32 from various colleges. Besides these students of B. K. Birla Colleges also displayed their projects in the exhibition. Every department of our college had put the 5 best projects in the competitions while nearly 25 from each department formed the display for the internal exhibitions of their respective department. Thus, there were about 200 projects for internal exhibition and 130 projects for external exhibition.

K. C. College, Churchgate, S. K. Somiya College, Ghatkopar, R. J. College, Ghatkopar were some of the city colleges besides K. M. Agrawal College, K. V. Pendharkar College, CHM College, etc. from the catchment area of Kalyan.

Holy Faith English School, St. Thomas English School, SICES High School, etc. were among the schools from which we received participation besides our management-run schools, Century Rayon High School, and B. K. Birla Public School.

With the generous support of the management of our college, we could institute a generous cash prize of Rs. 41500/- (Rupees forty-one thousand five hundred only) in total.
