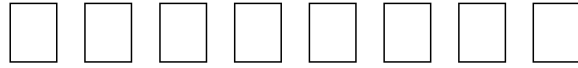

8th Students International Conference on Research

The Ecofest consists of three different events on the said theme viz., Essay Writing Competition, Poster Making Competition and 3D Model Making Competition/ Exhibition.

On 20th March 2024, Essay Writing Competition and Poster Making Competition were organized on the topics; Development at the cost of Environment, International Openness to Trade and India as a Youngest Nation in the World: Opportunity or Challenge.
